Upper Kiewa Landcare's on-going works at the Rock Pools and Mermaid Beach has been recognised recently in *The Age* newspaper in an article "Six reasons to visit Mount Beauty".

The major focus of 2012 works has been the control and clearing of blackberry infestations and other weeds that have engulfed the area. We are also very thankful to the support given by the Landmate team (Beechworth Correctional Facility) who have done a mighty job with spraying and clearing of weeds, constructing tracks and fencing. Release of new PestSmart Resources - Rabbits and Wild dogs



In the last few months, some new PestSmart resources have been finalised and are now available on the web at www.feral.org.au/pestsmart. The PestSmart Toolkit provides information and guidance on best-practice invasive animal management on several key vertebrate pest species including rabbits, wild dogs, foxes, feral pigs, feral cats, carp, and tilapia. Information is provided in various forms such as fact sheets, case-studies, technical manuals and scientific reports. Some examples of the new products include the glovebox guide for managing rabbits, the working plan to manage wild dogs, guidelines for preparing a working plan to manage wild dogs, and many more. Summer dung beetles active in Kiewa Catchment area and beyond

After a couple of very quiet summers, it is very pleasing to note that the summer dung beetle species, *Onthophagus taurus* and *Euoniticellus fulvus* have come back into full swing. We are also very pleased that several other beetle species have been sighted and appear to be increasing in numbers, in particular *Geotrupes spiniger* and *Onthophagus binodis*. It will be interesting to see what sort of season it will be for our winter beetles – all reports most welcome!
